Why We Publish

- For the field → progress of science
- As a career advancement tool
- To teach others
- To learn
- It's the right thing to do

What to Publish

- Reviews
 - Systematic or Critical review
 - Meta-analytic review
- Letters, short communications
- Brief research articles
- Regular research articles
- Special formats

Know Your Audience and Message

- The message

- How does it advance the field
- What gap does it fill
- Significance, fills a gap

- The audience

- Who can use the information, and for what
- Competing priorities

...and on that basis...

- Choose the journal

- Instructions for authors

Preparing Your Paper

- Authorship
 - Criteria
 - Intellectual contribution
 - Responsible for the data/product
 - Approves the final manuscript
 - Order
 - Explicit agreement
- Citation priorities
 - Readers
 - Editors
 - Reviewers

Ethical issues

- Conflict of interest
- Plagiarism
- Simultaneous submission
- Fraud – fabrication of data
- “Slicing and dicing”

Disseminating Your Work

- Search engine optimization
- Conference presentations
- Media
 - Social
 - Press
 - Broadcast
- Media relations office

Monitoring Your Impact

- Metrics
 - # collaborations
 - # articles
 - Usage: # times viewed
 - Journal impact factor
 - H-index

Question: *what other ways do you use to disseminate important information?*

Finding a Journal

- Look at your paper's bibliography
- Ask your peers
- Review the journals you read
- Examine the journal's website
- Check the masthead and table of contents
- Study the author instructions
- Run a database search
- Talk with a librarian

Predatory Publishers

- Did the journal send you an unsolicited e-mails or even SPAM?
- Are there grammatical errors in the correspondence?
- Ask if there are Article Processing Charges (APCs) or author fees.
- Ask if you can rescind your submission at any time.
